Heart Pondering

Luke 2:1-20

Luke 1:1-4 (NASB)

Since many have undertaken to compile an account of the things accomplished among us, just as they were handed down to us by those who from the beginning were **eyewitnesses** and servants of the word, it seemed fitting to me as well, **having investigated everything carefully** from the beginning, to write it out for you in **an orderly sequence**, most excellent Theophilus; so that you may know **the exact truth** about the things you have been taught.

Luke 2:1-20 (NASB)

Now in those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus, that a census be taken of all the inhabited earth. This was the first census taken while Quirinius was governor of Syria.

And all the people were on their way to register for the census, each to his own city.

Now Joseph also went up from Galilee, from the city of Nazareth, to Judea, to the city of David which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and family of David, in order to register along with Mary, who was betrothed to him, and was pregnant.

While they were there, the time came for her to give birth. And she gave birth to her firstborn son; and she wrapped Him in cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

In the same region there were some shepherds staying out in the fields and keeping watch over their flock at night. And an angel of the Lord suddenly stood near them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them; and they were terribly frightened.

And so the angel said to them, “Do not be afraid; for behold, I bring you good news of great joy which will be for all the people; for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.
