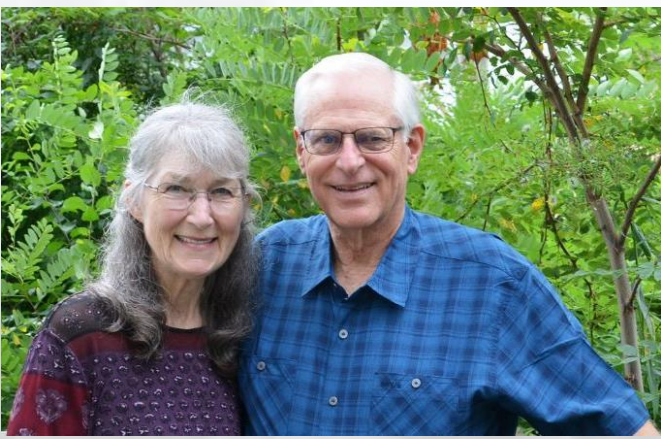

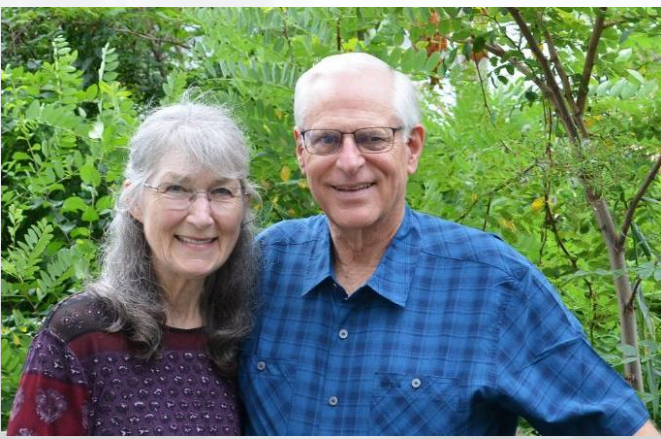

Tax Collectors, Sinners, Pharisees

Luke 5:27-39

Luke 5:27-39 (NASB)

After that He went out and looked at a tax collector named Levi sitting in the tax office, and He said to him, "Follow Me." And he left everything behind, and got up and began following Him.
